PARTICIPATION IN THE FORUM

Requests for participation in the Forum should be submitted until **May 30, 2015** by using the Application Form available on its website (Request for Participation). Please send the filled in request form to the address of contact. Within one week after this date the forum committee will notify you about acceptance of your proposals.

Forms of participation:

- Paper delivered at the Conference
- Corporate presentation at the Conference
- Presentation in the specialized exhibition ProKARSTerra 2015
- Participation in the International Competition "Karst under protection gift for the future generations"

For Conference participants with papers 2 ways of presentation will be offered:

- Oral presentation up to 20 minutes (last 5 minutes for discussion)
- Poster presented at a special poster session.

Papers full texts should be submitted **until 23 August.** They should be original (unreported and unpublished). Contents should comply with at least one of the topics of the Forum and papers should be delivered by at least one of the authors.

Papers will be published in:

- **1. Proceedings** (in full color, with ISBN number). The proceedings will be issued in digital form and will be included into the Conference materials. Papers (up to 10 pages, including summary, graphs, tables, references) will not be reviewed and edited. They should be submitted in one of the working languages, with summary in English. Paper template will be offered, published at the Conference web site.
- **2.** A book "Protected Karst Areas Lifelong Learning" (in English). The authors of some papers, selected by the Forum Committee will be invited to submit them for publication in this special edition. They will be refereed by independent anonymous reviewers. About further requirements and layout the authors will receive additional instructions. The book will be published after the Conference and will contain the documents adopted by the Forum.

FORUM VENUE





The international forum will be held in **Sofia**, the capital of Bulgaria, which is a member of the European Union (2007). Sofia (1.3 million) is the largest city in Bulgaria and its capital. It is the most important academic and cultural center in this country and city of rich archaeological and historical heritage, visited by many tourists.

Host of the forum is the **Bulgarian Academy of Sciences** – the oldest and most authoritative Bulgarian academic institution, which celebrated its 145 anniversary in 2014. The Conference sessions will be held in Central building of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences, located in the city center, next to the Bulgarian Parliament.
