INVITATION



Dear colleagues,

Global changes and the problems caused by them are already an indisputable fact. Against this background, the specific karst territories, occupying an impressive part of the Earth and the lives of millions of people, living there, are particularly vulnerable to changes and impacts. The consequences are already very serious and require urgent measures to ensure the sustainable development of karst areas.

As karstologists and speleologists we are professionally responsible and we realize the seriousness of these issues. That is why an open scientific discussion on the state and principles of management of karst territories is well-timed. Especially important are the problems of updating the legislative and regulatory framework and introduction of the principles of sustainable development. There are many topical issues and problems on national and international levels. Through the themes of the upcoming conference we invite you to discuss these problems together in Sofia.

At the same time, karst territories and sites are very attractive for different forms of tourism, especially cave tourism. Its development may have dangerous consequences for the sustainable development of karst territories. But tourism can and should have a positive effect too. It helps the local economy; it stimulates nice emotions, which contributes to the physical and mental health of people; it may have high educational effect, learning about karst and through karst. The balance between beneficial and harmful results from tourism in karst areas will also be discussed at this conference. This balance can be controlled by integrated monitoring. So another major topic will be what kinds and models of monitoring have been developed.

Integrated monitoring requires co-operation and good synchronization. It is necessary to organize international scientific networks and modern science infrastructure, focusing on model areas representative for various manifestations of active global change. Karst geosystems, being some of the most sensitive and vulnerable ones, are ideal for this purpose. They offer also natural underground laboratories. Integrated monitoring is also the basis for a wide international scientific and practical network. It will be a tool for tracking, analyzing and assessing impacts of global change on karst, and the role of karst in global change. Some ideas for such a network will be presented and discussed at the workshop prior to the conference. The potential of such a network as a basis for a new strategy for sustainable development of karst territories will be among the main issues discussed at the Round Table in the closing part of the conference.

There are many practically important problems in karst regions, the solution of which should not be delayed. In most cases these problems are due to the ignorance and disregard of karst and karst system's specifics. Despite the vast amount of research on karst and caves, authorities of different levels remain indifferent. This is especially dangerous, since rulers and politicians should have their responsibilities for the sustainable development of karst areas. This concerns strongly the life of people inhabiting them and depending on them. Unfortunately, karst continues to remain "Terra incognita".

The ProKARSTerra`2019 forum and the conference aim to discuss how to build a constructive integration between research, management, education and business. The success of this integration provides a basis for a new strategy for the sustainable development of karst territories in the context of global change - a key topic of the Round Table.

The upcoming conference in Bulgaria is the fourth one under the ProKARSTerra emblem. And that is not accidental. Karst in Bulgaria covers 1/4th of its territory. It is not only rich in caves (over 6000), but with its exceptional variety and human presence from deepest antiquity, it is a unique natural laboratory. Several generations of karstologists and speleologists work in it with serious scientific contributions, but this is still poorly known to the international scientific community. The geographic position of the Bulgarian karst also gives it a strategic advantage in studying the global changes and their effects on the contemporary karst genesis.

The conference with its planned field session and scientific excursion is an opportunity to explore, though partially, the diversity of karst in Bulgaria. This will be helped by a specialized exhibition where tour operators working at different karst sites will be invited, as well as producers of original items in karst areas. Comparing world traditions and good practices will create the basis for new ideas, and why not – for creation of new karst inspired brands...

We are looking forward to meet you in Bulgaria.
